TP Mechanical believes an investment in a strong workforce is an investment in our company. Started in 1982, our **paid**, **four-year** Apprenticeship Program provides quality instructors, teamwork and training for our future workforce.

In-person classes are held one night per week in Cincinnati, Columbus and Dayton. The class term runs from August to April.

- All instructors are TP Mechanical employees.
- Up to 30 college credit hours can be earned through Columbus State Community College.
- There is no cost to be in the program, and apprentices receive a full salary and benefits with potential salary increases every six months.
